A Special Meeting of the Town of Olathe Board of Trustees was held as a hybrid meeting on Tuesday, August 30, 2022. Said meeting was posted in accordance with the Sunshine Law. Mayor Jake Foreman called the Meeting to order at 7:02 P.M. with Town Administrator Rob Smith leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

ACTION ITEMS

5.3) OLATHE HIGH SCHOOL HOMECOMING ACTIVITIES

Olathe High School Head Boy, Owen Wagner and Head Girl, Tanner Carroll requested approval from the Board to paint Highway 50 Business Loop in front of the High School on September 11, 2022 to kick-off OHS Homecoming Week; and the students presented the Board with a Parade Permit for the Homecoming Parade on September 16, 2022. The students requested to have fees waived.

A motion by Trustee Steve Gottlieb approving the OHS class of 2023 to paint Highway 50 Business Loop in front of the school was seconded by Trustee Darrin Westermann. Trustee Gottlieb amended his initial motion to include the approval of the Parade Permit for the OHS Homecoming Parade and to waive any associated fees. The amended motion was seconded by Trustee Westermann. Discussion – None.

The motion passed with a seven to zero vote in favor.
