REGULAR MEETING

A Regular Meeting of the Town of Olathe Board of Trustees was held as a hybrid meeting on Monday, April 24, 2023. Said meeting was posted in accordance with the Sunshine Law. Mayor Jake Foreman called the Meeting to order at 7:00 PM with OPD Chief Frank Rodriguez leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Chief Rodriguez, Police Department

- Completed Colorado POST certification.
- The OPD Facebook was shut down for unforeseen reasons, working to get that back up and running.
- The Department still has three openings and four active applicants.
- Officer Fogg is attending negotiator training.
- Has sold both Chargers and purchased two Explorers from Montrose Police Dept.
- Has traded off the old service guns for new 9 mil 47 Glocks.

Heath Terrell, Public Works Department

- Clean-up week is complete and unofficial numbers are 22 tons of extra trash and large items that was collected.
- Discussed with the Board to remove a problem tree on the river due to the high-water level predictions.
