Municipal Election Candidate Packets Available January 4th

The 2022 Olathe Municipal Election will be held on **April 5, 2022**. There will be four Trustee seats open. The current Board whose seats are open are; Ruth Dodge, Mayor Pro Tem (term limited), Ruby Loya, Trustee, Darrin Westermann, Trustee, and Christine Kinion, Trustee. Term limited Trustees have served two consecutive terms and are not eligible to run for that office this election. Anyone interested in running for Trustee position may pick up candidate nomination packets beginning January 4, 2022, from Monique Garrett, Town Clerk, or they are available for download at www.townofolathe.org. Eligibility requirements include, 18 years of age, resided in the Town of Olathe (in the town limits) for the prior 12 consecutive months and be a registered voter. To get on the ballot, candidate must complete a candidate petition that includes 10 valid signatures and turn in all the required forms and documentation.
