## **Town To Refinance Sewer Treatment Facility**

Town Administrator, Patty Gabriel, has found a way to save the Town more than \$208,000. The savings, created by a reduced interest rate, will occur over the course of the repayment of the Sewer Treatment Facility loan with the original length of the loan staying the same. Ms. Gabriel said the savings will be realized in small amounts each year and will be used for building reserves in the sewer fund.
