## CDC OFFERS WINTER SAFETY TIPS


- Winterize your home.
  - Install weather stripping, insulation, and storm windows.
- Insulate water lines that run along exterior walls.
- Clean out gutters and repair roof leaks.
- Check your heating systems.

Have your heating system serviced professionally to make sure that it is clean, working properly, and ventilated to the outside.

- Inspect and clean fireplaces and chimneys.
  - Have a safe alternate heating source and alternate fuels available.
- If you do not have a working smoke detector, install one. Test batteries monthly and replace them twice a year.
- Prevent carbon monoxide (CO) poisoning emergencies.

Install a CO detector to alert you of the presence of the deadly, odorless, colorless gas. Check or change the battery when you change your clocks in the fall and spring.

- Learn the symptoms of CO poisoning: headache, dizziness, weakness, upset stomach, vomiting, chest pain, and confusion.

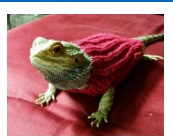

## Olathe Municipal Election 4/5/2022

4 Board of Trustee seats are up for election; (2) 4-year terms & (2) 2-year terms. To get on the ballot, a candidate must be 18 years of age, resided in the Town of Olathe (in town limits) for the prior 12 consecutive months, be a registered voter, complete a candidate petition that includes 10 valid signatures, and turn in all required forms and documentation.
