WHAT YOU CAN DO TO SUPPORT OUR DRIVER

Keep trash bins at least 3 feet apart from each other



Set bins with lid opening facing the street

No building material such as large lumber, concrete, large cardboard, or heavy metals

No extra trash near bin will be picked up

Do not over pack bins



Because of health risks, it is necessary to keep your garbage in a clean and sanitary manner. All other garbage such as furniture, construction materials, electronics, renovation debris and appliances will not be collected. These items are collected during Clean Up Week. Placing trash bins together slows trash pickup, and may prevent trash pickup. These items can be taken to Montrose Recycling Center, 67999 Landfill Road, Montrose (800)963-4776
