CDOT and DOLA Awards help the Town with New Sidewalks and Road

The 3rd Street project is almost complete and the Town Board of Trustees and staff would like to thank CDOT, Fletch's Excavation and Upland Construction for all of their hard work and professionalism in completing this project. Funding used for this project was from CDOT's Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) Award of \$225,271, DOLA's Energy Impact Assistance Grant of \$663,000 and the \$4 Road Improvement Fee collected monthly from Olathe residents on their utility

bills. The committed perseverance from the Town of Olathe Board of Trustees and Town staff has been to improve roads and have safe accessible lighted walking paths for residents. This project included a storm water drain expansion, new sidewalks with lighting, curb and gutter that connects the two local schools, a defined All Points Transit bus stop and the paving of 3rd street. The project will be completed on time and ready for the first day of Elementary School on August 21st.
