10-7-1: Definitions (Ord. 2010-07)

Campground: Organized campgrounds, including all Federal, State, County and Municipal owned or designated roadside parks and campgrounds and privately owned campgrounds, which are made available, either with or without a fee to the public.

10-7-2 Adoption and Application of Codes

- A. That certain document, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the Town Clerk and which may be inspected during regular business hours and additional copies of which are available for purchase, being marked and designated the Standards and Regulations for Campgrounds, as published by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Consumer Protection Division (6 CCR 1010-9), as amended from time to time, be and is hereby adopted for the Town of Olathe, State of Colorado, for regulating and governing campgrounds; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefore; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms are on file in the office of the Town of Olathe are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this ordinance.
- B. Amendment to the Standards and Regulations for Campgrounds in the Town of Olathe:
 - i. Maximum length of continuous stay at a campground will be 90 days. Camper must move out of campground for a minimum of 30 days before returning. Any currently operating campground shall not be required to comply with this section of the ordinance.
 - ii. As defined in Section 19-1 (C.R.S. Section 25-13-114) Maximum fine shall be punished by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars.

10-7-3 Licenses

- A. Application for a license or renewal thereof shall be made on forms provided by the Town of Olathe and accompanied by a fee of \$25.00. Licenses shall be valid from January to December of each year.
